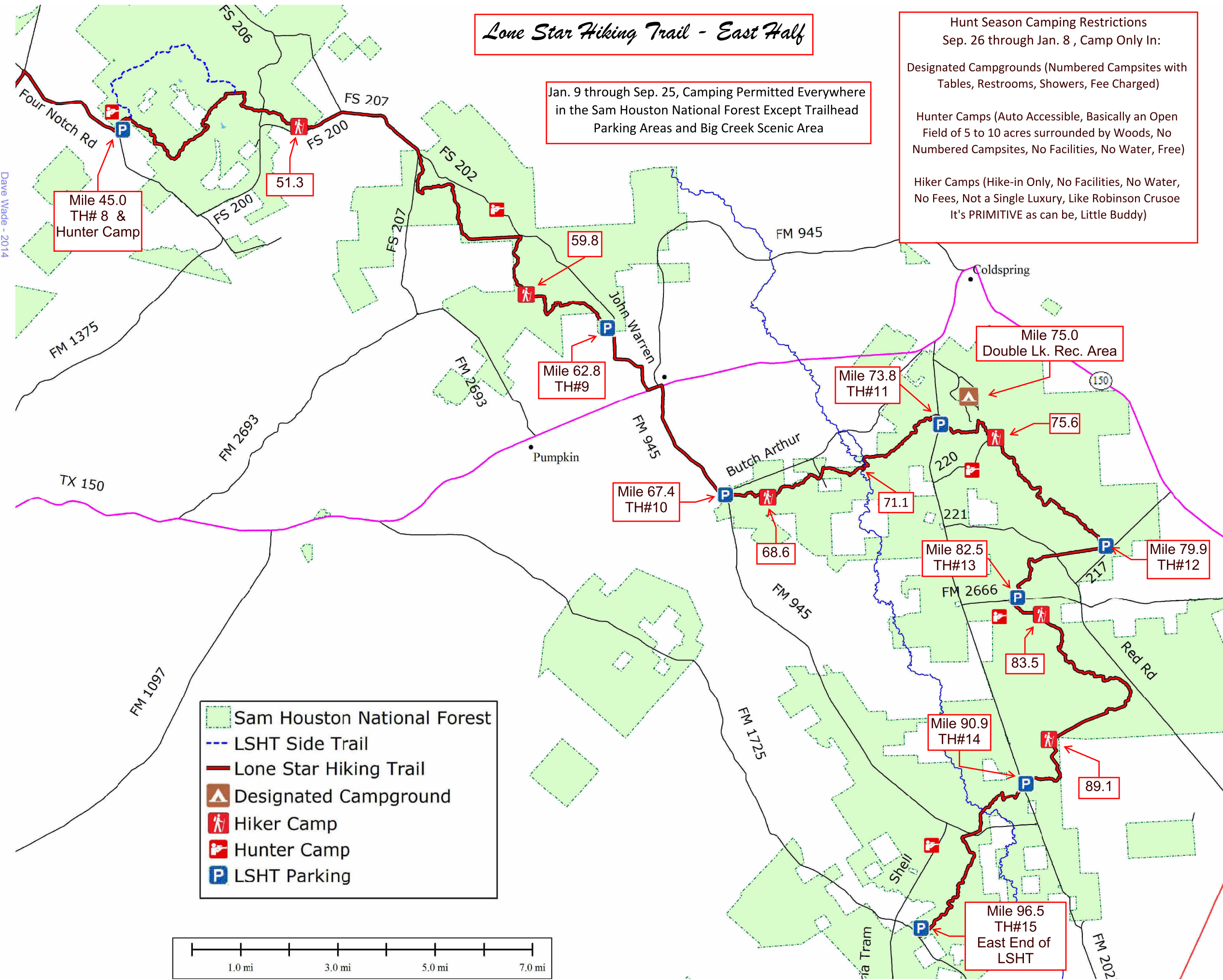


Lone Star Hiking Trail - East Half

Hunt Season Camping Restrictions
 Sep. 26 through Jan. 8, Camp Only In:
 Designated Campgrounds (Numbered Campsites with Tables, Restrooms, Showers, Fee Charged)
 Hunter Camps (Auto Accessible, Basically an Open Field of 5 to 10 acres surrounded by Woods, No Numbered Campsites, No Facilities, No Water, Free)
 Hiker Camps (Hike-in Only, No Facilities, No Water, No Fees, Not a Single Luxury, Like Robinson Crusoe It's PRIMITIVE as can be, Little Buddy)
